The Nottingham Acute Kidney Injury Course

Acute kidney injury (AKI) is common, harmful and costly. However it is often preventable and reversible through a greater awareness of risk factors and from early detection, recognition and prompt management. With a greater knowledge and understanding of AKI, significant improvements in patient care and outcomes can be achieved.

This course aims to give the clinician a comprehensive and up to date overview of the prevention, early detection and management of AKI. Including an overview of current staging systems, optimal fluid management, medical management of complications of AKI and AKI in special circumstances. The course combines didactic teaching sessions with case based discussions all of which are delivered by consultants with experience in acute medicine, nephrology, radiology and urology.

The course is aimed at doctors of all grades who wish to undertake a comprehensive overview on the subject, particularly those undertaking training in nephrology, acute medicine, health care of the elderly, critical care and also emergency medicine.

Course Venue

The East Midlands Conference Centre located at The University of Nottingham. It is easily accessible by car, train and bus. Free parking is available at the conference centre.



By Car

Easy access from the M1 with plentiful car parking options.

From the M1 North to University Park

Leave the M1 motorway at junction 26 and follow the A610 signposted to Nottingham. After approximately 2.5 miles turn right at lights onto the A6514 Nottingham ring road (Western Boulevard). Follow the A6514 to Middleton Boulevard and then take the slip road towards the Queen's Medical Centre roundabout. Take the third exit at the roundabout onto the A52, Derby Road. Turn left at the next roundabout (Toby Carvery) onto the A6464 Woodside Road. Turn left at the next roundabout to enter the University Park's West Entrance.

From the M1 South to University Park

Leave the M1 motorway at junction 25 and follow the A52 signposted to Nottingham. After approximately 4.4 miles turn right at the roundabout (Toby Carvery) onto the A6464 Woodside Road. Turn left at the next roundabout to enter the University Park's West Entrance.

For satellite navigation the postcode for University Park is NG7 2RJ, Beeston Lane. An alternative postcode for the main Trent building is NG7 2RD

By Train

The nearest train station to University Park is Beeston Station, although there are no taxi ranks at Beeston station. Nottingham train station is a short taxi ride away with taxi ranks. Phone 08457 484950 for further information.
